WOMEN AND GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

Around 25th of November, the Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women, the Ministry of Equality is organising a series of learning conferences and debates.

This conference programme will have two discussions and six online conferences, that will take place from the 5th of November to the 17th of December. The seminars propose to debate around different aspects related to violence against women, addressing femicide, sexual violence, masculinities and gender violence, intersectionality and gender violence; sexual exploitation, human rights and the State's duties to fight against gender violence. As well as that, there will be an institutional conference with the presence of members of parliament and senators to talk about the institutionalization of the State Pact against gender violence.

Local and internationally-qualified experts in each of these areas will participate in these conferences. As well as academically qualified experts, the conferences will also include people with knowledge from personal, work, activist and militant experience.
